



Stratton and Winhall Students

As an independent regional community school, The Mountain School at Winhall (MSW) accepts all Stratton and Winhall students. All students are accepted on the basis of the child's desire to learn and ability to participate in the orderly processes of the school, the parent's support of MSW and its curriculum, and MSW's ability to provide a program.

For a student from Stratton or Winhall, residency must be established in his/her town and verified by his/her school board, i.e. Stratton or Winhall School Boards. Students are required to go through the application process; however, the application fee is waived.

Stratton and Winhall residents are expected to follow MSW's enrollment calendar. Adherence to this calendar will ensure that space will not be an issue for your child. MSW recognizes that there are parents who become residents after the enrollment date for current town residents. For these new residents, MSW, upon receipt of records, will expedite the admission process.

For Stratton and Winhall children who qualify for special education and/or 504 Services, arrangements may be made to receive services through a written agreement between The Mountain School at Winhall and the Windham Central Supervisory Union as per our agreement. Parents are responsible to contact WCSU to set-up services.

If voters in Winhall or Stratton do not approve the school's tuition at an annual or special town meeting, students for that town currently enrolled at MSW will retain the full rights and privileges accorded to all students so long as the parent or guardian understands and accepts his/her financial responsibility to pay the difference.

Dover Grades 7/8 Students

For any grades 7/8 student that has been accepted to The Mountain School at Winhall, MSW accepts the student tuition payment from the town of Dover. This tuition payment covers full tuition to The Mountain School for the entire school year for students in grades 7 and 8 only. Students are required to go through the application process.

Transportation to The Mountain School must be provided by the parent(s). Dover students may be able to purchase a seat on the Town of Winhall School Bus that will transfer students from a designated place in Stratton. To contact the Winhall School Board, please call (802) 297-2128.

Any Dover student who qualifies for special education and/or 504 services must contact the Windham Central Supervisory Union (WCSU) in order to receive services at The Mountain School. MSW does not provide any special services.
