

Community Service

In order to help provide an educational experience that promotes each student's sense of responsibility for self, others, and surroundings, MSW participates in community service at each grade level. While in-school service is traditionally expected, out-of-school service helps foster community relationships and a sense of belonging beyond the "four walls" of the school. At The Mountain School, community service will be expected at each grade level. The requirements per classroom are:

- Pre-K/Kindergarten—1 classroom project
- 1st/2nd Grade—1 classroom project
- 3rd/4th Grade—1 classroom project
- 5th/6th Grade—1 classroom project; 3 independent hours of outside service a year
- 7th/8th Grade—1 classroom project; 5 independent hours of outside service a year

All classroom projects will be monitored by the classroom teacher. Parents may be asked to volunteer by the classroom teacher. Independent community service hours are to be performed outside of the student's primary residence and outside of regular school times and calendars. These hours are to be documented by an adult who has monitored or helped perform the task(s). Provide the date(s), time(s), and description(s) of the service(s) performed. The monitoring adult must sign the document before submittal.
