

F-23 Re-Enrollment Policy

The parents or legal guardians of currently enrolled children will be offered the opportunity to re-enroll their children for the following school year. Re-enrollment is conditioned upon timely submission of the re-enrollment form and acceptance by the Head of School. Parents or legal guardians who fail to submit re-enrollment forms by the date set by The Board of Trustees, will be considered to have withdrawn their children from The Mountain School at Winhall. Parents or legal guardians may request, in writing, a 30-day extension to the re-enrollment deadline date established annually by the Board. The Board must receive the request at least 15 days prior to the deadline in order to be considered. If the extension is granted and, if after 30 days from the enrollment deadline date, the student has not been re-enrolled, that student will be considered to have been withdrawn from MSW. MSW bears no obligation to hold a place for child(ren) once the child(ren) has withdrawn. Parents or guardians who subsequently wish to send their child(ren) to MSW are required to apply for re-admission (See Re-admission Policy).
