Admissions Information

The Mountain School at Winhall (MSW) is a Vermont-approved K-6 community-based independent day school serving Winhall, Stratton, and beyond students. MSW invites children from any community to apply for admission. Students entering Kindergarten are typically five (5) years of age by September 30 of that school year.

The Mountain School does not discriminate on the basis of race, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, religion, or in any other manner in the admission of students, the awarding of scholarships, or other tuition assistance.

Acceptance of all students to whom MSW can provide appropriate educational services will be based upon the child's desire to learn and the parent's support of the school and its curriculum. MSW is not required to admit students with criminal records, a history of substance abuse, or students at risk of physical or psychological harm to themselves or other students, property, or the orderly processes of the school.

Admission Process

The admission process cannot be finalized until The Mountain School at Winhall has received the completed admissions application, previous school records, and any other required admissions procedures have been completed.

After completing the application process, the Head of School will notify families of their child's enrollment status within 7 days. Once notified, parents have 15 days to return a signed Enrollment Agreement Form to the school to hold placement for the child. Unless otherwise arranged with the Head of School, the student will lose his/her/their placement at MSW without this confirmation from the family.

Please download Parts I and II of the Application for Admission to your computer. Families should complete Part I of the Application (open in Adobe Reader) and email or mail Part II (Grade-Based Evaluation Forms) to their child's school.
